Born in Minas, Departamento de Lavalleja, Uruguay 1906, died in Montevideo 1946; physician, professor of medicine at the university of Montevideo; militant and publicist, political friend of Simón Radowitzky; held radio talks on democracy, against dictatorship, etc.; ideologist and founder of the Sindicato Médico del Uruguay in the 1940s.
